AGE CATEGORY INFORMATION

All non-Physical Education events will be contested in Under 16 and Open Category. The U16 Category is for students who do not turn 16 in the year of the Convention. The Open Category is for students 16 years and over. Students who have not yet turned 16 may only enter Open Category events if they are in a team with students 16 years or older.

Physical Education events will be contested in three categories - Under 14 Category, Under 17 Category & Open Category. The U14 Category is for students who do not turn 14 in the year of the Convention. The Under 17 Category is for students aged 14 - 16 and who do not turn 17 in the year of Convention. The Open Category is for students 17 years and over.

Under 14 and Under 17 students may only enter an older age category if they are in a team with older students.

(See AT.2 and SP.2 for specific Physical Education Age Categories.)

COMBINED GROUP INFORMATION

Schools and HSSPs may enter combined teams under the following conditions:


- 1. Schools or HSSPs who do not have enough students registered for Convention to meet the minimum numbers required for an event may combine to form a team or group.
- 2. A list of all students entering the combined team/group event must be submitted to SCEE with a completed Application for Combined Teams/Groups Events Form with Registration. (see IN.21)
- 3. Once approval from SCEE has been received by email no changes to the team/group will be allowed.
- 4. School or HSSPs must organise any combined teams/groups themselves by registration date. SCEE is not able to organize combined teams/groups.

SPONSORS' RESPONSIBILITIES

This Sponsors notice is provided to give you a brief overview of the responsibilities you will have as the leader of your young people at Student Convention. It is important to remember that the Convention Director is the final authority.

- To be eligible as a Sponsor you must be at least twenty-one years of age and hold the appropriate Working with Children clearances if required.
- There must be at least one male sponsor for every one-to-ten boys and one female sponsor for every one-to-ten girls in your group.
- A school/family may assume responsibility for students from another school/family, provided this does not exceed the one-to-ten ratio.
- A female sponsor must sponsor only female students, and a male sponsor must sponsor only male students. There is an exception for families parents may sponsor their own children, however a parent attending full-time and sponsoring a child of the opposite gender may not take responsibility for any other full-time students of other families or schools.
- All students must be directly responsible to a specific sponsor at all times.
- You are the key to good attitudes and cooperative spirits among the students. If sponsors complain, argue or "test" the rules, their students will mirror these attitudes during the week.
- Your first Convention responsibility is to your assigned students. If you are planning to judge, please indicate on your Sponsor Registration Form who will be directly responsible for your students while you are judging.
- You must reside with your students where assigned and it is your responsibility to ensure punctuality to events and meals, and to have your students in their respective rooms, ready for bed before lights out.
- All sponsors and students must be present the entire week of the Convention and must attend all rallies and remain until dismissed.
- It is important that you spend time leading your students in daily devotions during Convention. Daily devotions are a necessary tool for training our young people in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.
- Sponsors and students are to show deference to those who practice denominational distinctives at their local churches. Convention participants are asked to abide by the principles of Romans 12:10 during the Convention, "Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another,...". Sponsors and students are asked to refrain from discussing denominational distinctives with anyone outside their own group during Convention.
- Events at Student Convention will be scheduled and contestants must be available to perform at those times. If there are clashes in the timetabling, the student and sponsor are to go directly to the Coordinator of the event and schedule a new time.

School Kit Regional A.C.E. Student Convention - 2019 • Please remember it is your responsibility to meet all dress code requirements and to ensure your students are also meeting the dress standards while at Convention. Do not allow yourself to be embarrassed, or your students to build a bad spirit, by failing to be an example of the dress standards to them.

DRESS CODE - Male and Female Students, Sponsors and Guests

- All shirts/blouses/dresses must cover the shoulders and have **complete** sleeves so that underarms cannot be seen.
- Necklines must be at or above the clavicle bone at the front and of an equal height or higher at the back.
- No clothing is to have "cut-outs" or similar openings.
- Midriffs must not be exposed even when stretching.
- Skirts/dresses minimum length must be such that they touch the floor when kneeling.
- Any splits in skirts or similar garments, must not be above the knee.
- No see through materials are permitted.
- No body hugging clothes are permitted.
- Shorts (including athletics shorts and splits in shorts) must not be shorter than the wearers' four fingers width above the top of the kneecap when standing.
- Shoes must be worn at all times including athletic events.
- PE uniform and/or other similar sports wear is not suitable for evening rallies and awards ceremonies.
- Please personally secure any sums of money brought by your students. SCEE does not assume any responsibility for theft or loss of money or valuables during Convention.
- Sponsors must retain all prescription medications for your students and dispense them only as prescribed. Please hold on to all medications that your students may require, whether prescription or non-prescription.
- Students are not permitted to leave the convention site unless accompanied by their sponsor or parent.
- Girls' rooms are off limits to all boys. Boys' rooms are off limits to all girls.
- You need to ensure that your students have plenty of drinking water at the Atheltics Day. They need to stay well hydrated throughout the day, regardless of weather conditions or temperature, especially if they are running races.

- Will not have responsibility as a sponsor or accompanist for any children or students attending the Convention.
- Will be willing to volunteer their time 24/7 for the duration of Convention in any Convention area (including judging, gofering, stage handling, sound and audio handling, etc.)
- Be able to arrive at the Convention site prior to commencement of Check-in and remain until after the Convention Awards Ceremony and campsite clean up has been completed.
- Be flexible in sleeping arrangements.
- Be passionate about the purpose and ministry of Student Conventions.

The successful applicants will need to:
